# UCF Downtown Safety & Security

- Partnered with **Orlando PD and Valencia College security** to develop a comprehensive safety and security plan, participate in ride-alongs and weekly crime meetings to understand trends in the area
- **Emergency Blue Light Phones** located throughout the campus
- **Well-lit with state-of-the-art camera systems**, which officers have access to
- Daytime security personnel for all buildings on campus
- UCF Downtown features **secured access entry technology** and a **valid UCF ID** is needed to gain access to certain areas of the buildings
- **License plate recognition technology** in parking garages flag suspicious activity
- UCF Downtown students, faculty and staff are automatically enrolled in the **UCF Alert mass notification system**, which provides text messages, emails and other notifications about emergencies on campus



UCFPD OFFERS MANY **SPECIALTY UNITS**, INCLUDING K-9, EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM, & CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS.



In addition to enforcing campus safety, officers conduct **proactive, educational outreach** and **offer free services** teach students about **personal safety** and **ways to protect themselves.**



# UCFPD Safety Tips

## Mighty Knights Self-Defense

- Free to students, staff, and faculty within the UCF community.
- Focuses on topics of mindset, preparation and safety awareness, but also demonstrates basic physical defense techniques.

## Property Crimes

- Don't leave personal items unattended on campus.
- Register personal property with UCFPD's free registration system.





# UCFPD Safety Tips

## Safe escorts

- Students, faculty and staff can request a walking escort anywhere on campus at any time by calling UCFPD's non-emergency line at **407-823-5555**.
- For UCF Downtown, call campus security at 407-235-3800

## Pedestrian safety

- Avoid distractions and stay aware of your surroundings
- As a pedestrian, wait until you have a signal to cross at designated crosswalks
- The minimum citation for failing to yield to a pedestrian is \$164 and three points on your driver's license. Even worse, someone could get severely hurt or killed.

# Confidentiality

- Our staff will maintain confidentiality with all clients who access our services, with the following exceptions:
  - Client is under 18 years of age,
  - Knowledge of suicidal or homicidal thoughts,
  - Knowledge of abuse of a child, elder, or person with a disability,
  - A judge orders the program to release information to the court, or
  - Client is working with the UCF Police Department and the perpetrator may pose a threat to the target and/or the UCF community to eliminate violence in our community through advocacy, education, and training.
