What is **Transfer Shock?**



Transfer Shock:

a term used in higher education to describe "the tendency of students transferring from on institution to another to experience a temporary dip in GPA during the first or second semester at the new institution" (Hills, 1965)

Situation:

What is going on at the time of the transition

Takeaways:

Transition takes time!

Gather information along the way

Take notes when learning something new

Make plans and schedules to stay on track and keep up with changes

Self:

Thinking about personal and demographic characteristics that can affect how you view your transition



Takeaways: *How you view yourself matters!*

Give yourself space to process and reflect as you begin your UCF journey

Set realistic expectations and goals for yourself











Support: Which relationships or networks you can rely on to aid in your transition

Get connected in/out of class and ask for help!

Build a community on campus

Embrace the idea of asking for help

Strategy: Method(s) you will use to manage your transition



NEED-TO-KNOW POLICIES



• Excess Credit Hours

- Penalty associated with "excess" courses (20% more than what is required for your major)
- Take only what is required!
- Grade Forgiveness
 - Limit on how many times it can be used
 - Times you can use this varies based on if you are coming to UCF with your AA or not
 - Talk to an advisor before deciding what to do!
